About the Wireless LINC Initiative

MISSION: To expand the region's economy and services by providing high speed, connectivity in Northern NH and Northeastern Vermont.

SERVICES: Initiating the project with a pilot centered in Lancaster, NH, *Wireless LINC* intends to build out to include our northern 3 counties of NH.

Wireless technology today is highly secure and easy to upgrade, offering state-of-the-art performance both now and as demands increase. This new Wireless Open-Access Network initiates through fiber connections in key areas that provide both primary and back-up sources and also helps with pricing competition. Such a design creates the first level in redundancy and survivability.

Wireless LINC intends to operate as a Regional Backhaul Internet Provider offering to Internet service companies a state-of-the-art infrastructure to operate on. At the same time, it will be a true open access solution, placing choice and opportunity in the hands of the end user. It is anticipated *Wireless LINC* can be instrumental in providing the region with low-cost, high performance broadband options, making this region competitive worldwide.

BETA Subscriber's Wanted:

Residents are now being contacted in our Phase 1 testing access field in the Lancaster/Whitefield/Dalton area. A few "Wireless Pioneers" are being recruited to agree to work with the project team to install a router in their home and experience high-speed Internet service via a connection from the tower on Mt. Orne at no cost.

In exchange for three months of free Broadband Internet Service, beta-testers are needed to provide feedback and suggestions on the connection speed, equipment installation, and tech support systems for this developing Network.

This network is deploying the latest in Wireless Technology using receivers which are easy to install on the inside of your home. An example of the equipment needed on a window facing the SouthWest (towards the tower on Mt. Orne) is this:



The receiver is attached to the window facing SouthWest with suction cups.



This is the Receiving Unit - Approx. 6 inches tall that attaches to the Window



This is the router that plugs into the Receiver and into your computer or Hub
